1. INTRODUCTION

This brochure serves as a guide for obtaining the Institute of Materials, Malaysia (IMM) Vibration assessment and certification. It is designed to satisfy the requirements of the oil and gas exploration and production (EP) industry, energy, marine, manufacturing and other industries for formally assessed and certified vibration practitioners in accordance with ISO 18436-2 and Oil and Gas industry standards.

The quality of vibration analysis and condition monitoring depends to a very large extent on the quality of the people who carry it out. It does not matter how good the monitoring equipment is or even how committed management is, the program will fall unless it is run by capable and dedicated people. What can be done to ensure the availability of capable and dedicated people? A professional certificate with performance objectives will be the answer.

There are four categories of Vibration certification:

- Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1
- Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2
- Certified Vibration Specialist Category 3
- Certified Vibration Specialist Category 4

2. WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1
 - Engineers, supervisors, inspections and technicians who wish to pursue a career as an IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner.
- ii. Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2
 - Technicians, supervisors, engineers or anyone who passed IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1 and is interested to upgrade his/her knowledge and career in vibration conditioned monitoring and analysing.
- iii. Certified Vibration Specialist Category 3
 - Technicians, supervisors, engineers or anyone who passed IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2 and is interested to upgrade his/her knowledge and career in vibration conditioned monitoring and analysing.

iv. Certified Vibration Specialist Category 4

 Technicians, supervisors, engineers or anyone who passed IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 3 and is interested to upgrade his/her knowledge and career in vibration conditioned monitoring and analysing.

3. EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT

The candidate will be assessed by IMM on their competency as follows:

Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1

A 2-hour theory examination will be conducted and consist of 60 multiple choice questions.

The criteria for competency is that the candidate must pass the examination with a minimum mark of 70%.

Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2

A 3-hour theory examination will be conducted and consist of 110 multiple choice questions.

The criteria for competency is that the candidate must pass the examination with a minimum mark of 70%.

The above assessments may be held at an Authorised Testing Centre (ATC) or immediately following the related training course conducted by Associate Training Partner (ATP)/Authorised Training Centre (ATB).

4. LANGUAGE

The lectures and assessments will be conducted in English or Bahasa Malaysia or local dialects (where possible).

5. CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY AWARDED

The certificate awarded for each category are as follows:

- IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1
- IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2
- IMM Certified Vibration Specialist Category 3
- IMM Certified Vibration Specialist Category 4

6. VALIDITY OF CERTIFICATION

5 years; qualified candidate must register as an IMM member for the certification period of 5 years.

7. CANDIDATE'S CRITERIA

<u>Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1</u>

Candidate should have

 Minimum academic qualification - SPM or equivalent* with at least credit in English and Mathematics

*Candidate fulfils the minimum academic qualification but without experience in vibrationrelated field is considered as a candidate without experience.

Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2

Candidate should have

• IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 1 and with at least 6 months working experience in vibration monitoring.

Certified Vibration Specialist Category 3

Candidate should have

 IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 2 and with at least 6 months working experience in vibration monitoring

Certified Vibration Specialist Category 4

Candidate should have

 IMM Certified Vibration Practitioner Category 3 and with at least 24 months working experience in vibration monitoring Candidate without experience is required to attend IMM approved/recognized training courses which prepares and provides comprehensive guidance and practice aligned to the topics covered in the examination.

Candidate with experience is encouraged to attend IMM approved/recognized training courses.

8. RESIT OF EXAMINATION

A candidate who had failed in one or more of the examination parts can apply to re-sit for the failed component(s) of the examination within a year from the date of the last examination. The candidate shall have to pay the full examination fee for the re-sit and without the need to attend any pre-requisite training course.

9. RE-CERTIFICATION

All certified IMM Vibration Practitioner or Specialist can apply for re-certification before the expiry of their certification period.

6 months prior to the expiry of certification (at the end of the 5th year of certification), the candidate can apply for re-certification for another 5 years by

- providing proof to IMM that he/she has been employed in a related profession; and
- accumulating sufficient Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points*.

Prior to the expiry of the 5-year re-certification (at the end of the 10th year of certification), the candidate can continue to be certified for a further 5-year period by

- providing proof to IMM that he/she has been employed in a related profession
- accumulating sufficient CPD points*; and
- attending the relevant Refresher Course for certification (if any).

The candidate must re-sit the certification examination if he/she has been out of the profession for more than 18 months continuously during the 5-year certification or recertification period.


* The minimum number of CPD Points to be accumulated over a 5-year period shall be 100 points with an annual requirement of at least 10 points.

10. TRAINING

Although this assessment program is intended for only experienced vibration practitioner or specialist, the candidate is strongly encouraged to attend IMM approved/recognized training courses of 4 - 5 more days to refresh themselves before attending the examination program by IMM. The IMM approved training courses are conducted by IMM certified trainers through IMM Authorised Training Body (ATB) or Associate Training Partner (ATP). Nevertheless, a prior training program for experienced vibration practitioner or specialist is not compulsory.

The **pre-assessment briefing and theory examination** will be conducted by IMM certified trainers/examiners through IMM ATP(s), ATB(s) or ATC(s) throughout Malaysia. Each session will be limited to 20 candidates.


